Into Film is an education charity that puts film at the heart of children and young people's educational, cultural and personal development.

Over two thirds of UK schools engage with the programme of Into Film Clubs, special cinema screenings, and resources and training to support classroom teaching. Alongside rich online content for young audiences, this provides 5-19 year olds with inspiring opportunities to learn about and with film, and develop a passion for cinema. Into Film's work is supported principally by the BFI through the National Lottery, and by the film industry through Cinema First.

I am very pleased to announce that we have been able to book all our Year 5 children to see a film at this year's Into Film Festival. We are going to see *Goosebumps 2: Haunted Halloween* on **Wednesday 14th November** at the Showcase Cinema in Bluewater Shopping Centre.
