Re: The Monstrous Child Matinee at the Royal Opera House - Years 5/6 on Monday 25th February 2019

We have the opportunity for **15 of our children** to attend the Royal Opera House in London, to see a matinee performance of **The Monstrous Child**. It's the story about the teenage daughter of a Norse God Loki, who tries to find her place in the mythical world. We have decided that the fairest way to distribute the tickets, is to gauge the interest from our parents for their children to attend, before placing tickets into a draw. Any children who didn't attend Carmen the Opera and want to attend this production, will receive priority in the draw.

We will be travelling by minibus to Dartford train station, and taking a train to the Royal Opera House via Charing Cross. From here, we will take a short walk to the venue. The production starts at 1:00pm, so we will be aiming to leave school at approximately 11:00pm. The children will be required to bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag. The production finishes at approximately 3:20pm, after which time we will return to Dartford train station, using identical travel arrangements. **Parents will be required to pick-up their children up at approximately 5:00pm from school.**

The cost for this trip is £15; which includes travel to and from the Royal Opera House, the ticket for The Monstrous Child, plus and ice-cream for the children during the interval of the show. **Payment will be due by Friday 15th February.**
