We have the wonderful opportunity for our Year 6 children to attend one of **Tate Modern's - Artist-Led School Workshops** on the afternoon of **Wednesday 27th February 2019**. The workshops are designed to encourage children to engage in art, culture and ideas that encourage them to voice their thoughts, aspirations and opinions in a unique and diverse way. Workshops are led by contemporary artists, who work at Tate over the course of a year. This is in-keeping with our vision at school for children to live 'life in all its fullness', encouraging them to step outside of their comfort zone and encounter new experiences. We will also take the children to see exhibits at the Tate Modern, so they can enjoy a full-day at the museum.

We will be travelling by minibus to Swanley train station, and taking a train to London Blackfriars, before taking a short walk to the **Tate Modern, Bankside, London SE1 9TG**. The afternoon workshop runs from 1:00pm until 2:30pm, after which time we will return via Blackfriars train station to Swanley, using identical travel arrangements. **Parents will be required to pick-up their children up at approximately 4:30pm from school.**
