Maple Survival Day

As part of our topic this term and to support our curriculum learning, we have been thinking about climate change and how the Earth might change over this century. **On Monday 11th March** we will be holding a 'Survival Day' for the children. This will include a range of activities including: shelter building, filtering water and fire lighting. For this to be able to take place, we ask if you could help us by supplying some equipment for your child.

As the children will be building shelters, we ask if you could supply them with any of the following: string, poles, rods, bamboo canes, old sheets or blankets that you no longer use, so that they can build their shelter. We already have some resources, but extra would really help!

Children should come in non-school uniform, dressed for survival in old clothes, wearing shoes and clothes that can get muddy.

In addition to this, we would like to show the children the film, *The Day after Tomorrow*; which will form the basis for in-class discussions and develop the children's imagination and creativity during their writing and learning this term. Whilst this is a 12 rated film, this guidance is for screening in cinemas only and not within schools or at home. Having watched the film, there is some mild swearing spoken by characters, which we believe would have made it a 12 rating at the time. If you would prefer that your child does not watch the film, alternative provision will be provided. Please indicate on the return slip below.
