Please find attached a Consent/Medical Form that needs to be completed and returned to school as soon as possible, together with a 'Packing List' (please note that most activities require long sleeves) Please label all clothing (permanent markers are good), so that any missing items can be easily located. Aerosols are not allowed, but roll-on deodorant's can be used. The centre is not responsible for any loss of property that a child brings. Please do not let your child bring anything valuable, electronic devices are NOT permitted; so no mobile phones, iPod's or games consoles etc.

We have organised a very busy and exciting programme of events comprising abseiling, climbing, archery, nightline, problem solving, 3GSwing, buggy build plus more! The children are set to have a really thrilling weekend.

There is a small shop on-site where children can buy snacks and souvenirs. We recommend that children bring a maximum of £10 spending money; please do not send your child with any more money than this. Can all pocket money and medication be given to Miss Craft on the Friday morning of the trip, in a clearly labelled bag/envelope.

We are hoping to arrive at the centre by 2pm, so will be leaving school shortly after lunchtime. We will confirm a departure time with you closer to the time, so that you are able to come and wave your children goodbye for their weekend adventure! The expected time of arrival back at school on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October, is approximately 2.30 pm, but we will contact you via School Gateway on the day.
