Birch Class Visit to Hall Place for an 'All About Owls' Workshop

As part of Birch Class's curriculum topic on 'The Life of an Owl', we have organised to take the children on a very special visit to Hall Place in Bexley, on **Friday 27th September**. The children will take part in a one hour 'Owl Workshop', which is run by Jambs Owls, who look after visitor-friendly barn owls, eagle owls and many other species. They will learn about how owls survive in the wild, what they like to eat and their nocturnal habits.

The class will depart from school after registration and travel via our school minibus to and from the venue and will return in time for normal school lunch. They will be accompanied by their class teacher Miss Searles and two further additional members of staff. We ask that you drop your child's car/booster seat off to their class on the morning of the visit, so that the children are able to sit in their own seats when they travel via our school minibus. The full address of the venue is Hall Place & Gardens, Bourne Road, Bexley, DA5 1PQ.

The cost of this visit is **£3 per child and should be paid directly via the School Gateway app**. Also, if you haven't already done so, we ask for a yearly contribution towards the cost of running the school minibus, which you can also pay via the School Gateway app.

Can we kindly ask that you make payment of £3 no later than **Wednesday 25th September**.
