Primary Proms at the Royal Albert Hall – Wednesday 9th October 2019

A fantastic opportunity has arisen for our Year 4 children to attend the 'Primary Proms' concert at the Royal Albert Hall, on **Wednesday 9th October 2019**. The children will be travelling via the school minibus to the **The Royal Albert Hall, Kensington Gore, London SW7 2AP**.

The music for Youth Primary Prom concerts are aimed at Key Stage 1 and 2 children, offering the opportunity for school students to experience live music making, in one of the world's most famous concert halls. Presenter Patrick Bailey, will guide the children through the concert and explore the instruments and sounds heard in a dynamic and eclectic performances by talented young musicians, and there will even be a chance for the pupils to be part of an audience participation piece!

The production starts at 10:35am and finishes at 12:00pm noon. Please can you bring your child to school at 08:30am on that day, so we are able to register and depart for London. We anticipate being back at school at approximately 2:00pm and it will be a normal school pickup time. We will alert you on the day via School Comms should the time change.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day, in a named disposable bag and a bottle of water.

This is a free school trip. However, if you haven't already done so, we please ask that you contribute to our annual school minibus fund via the School Gateway app. This pays for the cost of running our school minibus throughout the school year, enabling us to take the children on many exciting curriculum linked trips and sporting activities.
