Swanley Food Bank Required Items (no expired items please)

Tinned fish	Tinned/individual long life sponge puddings	Fruit juice (not chilled)
UHT milk	Tinned fruit	Tinned custard
Tinned rice pudding	Antibacterial spray	Washing-up liquid
Deodorant	Bars of soap	Toilet rolls (2 or 4 packs)
