With just a few days left before the group departs for its Kingswood Residential, here are some final details. The Centre is located in Ashford and the full address is **The Kingswood Centre, Grosvenor Hall, Kennington, Ashford, TN25 4AJ**. If you need to make contact with staff in the event of an emergency, the mobile number is **07396 371719**.

Mr Hulme, Miss Craft, Mr Johnson and Mr Ledger will be staying for the duration of the trip. **The group will be leaving school at the end of the school day on Friday at 3:15pm and travelling by minibus.** You are very welcome to come to school and wave them off! Children should come to school in their own clothes on Friday.

Can your child please bring a named water bottle, so that they are able to take water to each activity they take part in. I attach another copy of the kit list but children will need to wear long sleeves and trousers for most activities and long hair must be tied back. I have also included the programme schedule of all of the fun activities that the children will be taking part in over the duration of the weekend.

Can you please label all clothing so that any missing items can be easily located. Permanent marker pens are great for this! Remember that aerosols are not allowed but roll-on deodorants can be used. The Centre WILL NOT be responsible for any loss of personal property your child brings. Therefore, please do not let them bring anything valuable, including expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones, handheld games consoles etc. No electronic devices are permitted.

Your child may want to bring a book to read, a colouring or writing pad or a card game, for some activities for them to do before bed time and during other down times.

There is a small shop on site where children can buy snacks and souvenirs and we recommend that children bring no more than £10. **Can all pocket money and medication be given to Miss Craft on Friday morning in clearly labelled bags/envelopes, when you drop your child to school.**

The group **should be back at school by approximately 2.00 pm on Sunday** and you will be sent a text just before departure. Please check the Twitter feed on our website over the weekend for regular updates!
