Re: Year 5/6 Tag Rugby Festival at Dartford Valley Rugby Club – Tuesday 5th November 2019

Your child has been selected to take part in the above Tag rugby festival, taking place at **Dartford Valley Rugby Club, Cotton Lane, Dartford, Stone, Greenhithe, DA2 6QZ** on **Tuesday 5th November 2019**. The aim of this event is to provide a fun and enjoyable day for Year 5/6 children from 12 local primary schools and to play Tag Rugby in a meaningful and competitive environment. This will be an all-day event, starting at 09:45am and finishing at approximately 14:40pm. We anticipate children being back at school for a normal pickup time. Should the time change on the day, we will alert you via the School Gateway app.

Dartford Valley Rugby Club will kindly be providing a nut-free snack lunch, with a healthy soft drink and water for each pupil that attends. They cannot provide catering for children with any special dietary needs; should your child require a specified lunch, please provide them with a packed lunch for the day. You may also provide your child with a healthy snack to have throughout the day, such as a piece of fruit or nut-free cereal bar.

Parents are encouraged to attend this event. There is a large balcony overlooking the pitches and tea and coffee will be available. You will need to make your way to and from the venue.

A member of staff will be accompanying the children all day to and from the match and they will be travelling via our school minibus.

Please can your child bring in their football boots if they have them, or sensible trainers for outside play in muddy conditions. No bladed football boots are allowed and shin pads are not essential as Tag Rugby is a non-contact sport.

We already have your consent for your child to take part in sporting activities of this kind, but please let Mr Ledger or the School Office know as soon as possible, if your child cannot take part.
