Stone Age Workshop – Monday 13th January 2020

As part of our Stone Age project, we have organised a Stone Age Workshop on Monday 13th January. Beech Class will spend the day with a time-traveller who has been to the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages and has come back to share what she has learned.

Throughout the day, the children will explore what life was like for Stone Age hunter-gatherers, Iron Age farmers and storytellers from the age. The experience is filled with lots of memorable moments, including an opportunity to touch and feel mysterious Stone Age objects.

Finally, the children will get to listen to and tell their own Stone Age stories (accompanied by musical instruments) and participate in an Iron Age ceremony. The experience will help children to further their understanding of the Stone Age and enhance their learning this term.

We would like children to come to school in Stone Age outfits. These outfits do not have to be anything expensive; the children will be doing lots of activities throughout the day. Therefore, they will need to be appropriate for a day full of activities. Natural coloured clothes with cuts for effect would look great. Additionally, the children may have some fake animal fur they could wear. Dirty faces and wild hair would also be a great addition to the costume! Again, shoes need to be suitable for a day of activities indoors and out.

To help fund the cost of this workshop, we are kindly asking for a **£9** contribution per child. This should be paid via School Comms under the payment 'Stone Age Day'. This can be paid up until Friday 31st January 2020.
