### **Y4 Visit to Museum of the Moon at Rochester Cathedral on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

We are pleased to let you know that we have the exciting opportunity for our children to visit the **'Museum of the Moon' exhibit** at Rochester Cathedral, Garth House, Rochester, ME1 1SX **on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020.**

Museum of the Moon, is a touring artwork by UK artist Luke Jerram. It measures seven meters in diameter and features NASA imagery of the lunar surface. The children will receive an introduction talk on the moon, get time to enjoy the magic of the installation; even lying under the moon and gazing up at it as if on a dark full-mooned night! They will also have a chance to explore moon related facts and investigate how the moon and stars influenced medieval life as well as all the different cultures around the world, in a historical, cultural, scientific and religious way! Children will discover that despite many differences, the moon connects us all!

The children should bring a packed lunch on the day, in a throw away bag. The children will travel to and from the cathedral on the school minibus and should wear a full school uniform including their blazers.

The cost of this visit will be £2.50 per child. This includes travel to and from the cathedral via our school minibus, entry into the cathedral and the Museum of the Moon exhibit. This should be paid via School Comms under payments, 'Museum of the Moon'. **Please can you pay the full-amount by Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020.**

We already have your consent for your child to take part in external activities of this kind, but please let the School Office know as soon as possible if your child cannot take part.
