Birch Class Visit to Bluewater's Nature Trail of The Hungry Caterpillar

Birch class have the fantastic opportunity to visit Bluewater's nature trail of The Hungry Caterpillar on **Thursday 26th March 2020**, at **Bluewater, Greenhithe, DA9 9SG**. The children will have the opportunity to use a map and follow the trail on The Very Hungry Caterpillar themed adventure to explore the play areas, bug hotels, stepping logs and hopscotch.
