Year 6 PGL Day Trip to Windmill Hill – East Sussex– Friday 14th May 2021

I am very pleased to let you know, that we have managed to secure a really exciting day camp for our Year 6's to take part in, on Friday 14 May 2021. It was our aim to arrange a two-night residential trip for them, but in the current climate with government restrictions in place, this has not been possible for us to arrange. The day camp will take place at **Windmill Hill, East Sussex, Hailsham, BN27, 4RZ.**

The day will provide exciting and challenging activities, run by an experienced and qualified team of outdoor professionals. From activities such as abseiling, archery, canoeing, fencing raft building and zip wire, there is bound to be something for everyone! The focus for of the day is help on building friendships, teamwork skills and confidence; to take risks and persevere when faced with challenges. The children will gain a great deal from attending and take away fond memories of Year 6 and their friends at St. Paul's, which they can treasure long after they have left us!

The group will depart from St. Paul's at approximately 7:30am on Friday 14th May and will travel by the school mini-bus. They will be leaving the centre at approximately 4:15pm, arriving back at St. Paul's School by 5:30pm. We will keep you updated on the day via School Comms.

The cost of the day trip will be **£55** and this includes all activities and travel. We ask that the children bring a packed lunch on the day, with an extra sandwich and snacks, plus a water bottle that can be re-filled. We also ask that they wear full outdoor clothing, such as their outfit for forest school and that they also bring a change of clothes and a towel, should they get a little wet during their water sporting activity! We will send full details of what children should bring, closer to the date.

If you would like your child to attend, payment should be made via School Comms under the heading 'Year 6 PGL'. We have set this up as a rolling payment, so that you can pay as little as a £1, or the whole balance all at once. You can pay small amounts from now, up until Friday 7th May. Please also tick the consent box. We know that times have been very hard for many during the past year, so we hope that the rolling balance, will help.
