We are delighted that the Kingswood Residential trip has been given the green light to go ahead for your children. The Centre is located in Ashford and the full address is **The Kingswood Centre, Grosvenor Hall, Kennington, Ashford, TN25 4AJ**. If you need to make contact with staff in the event of an emergency only, the mobile number is **07396 371719**.

Miss Taylor, Miss Craft and Mr Johnson will be staying for the duration of the trip. **The group will be leaving school at the end of the school day on Friday at 3:15pm and travelling by minibus**. You are very welcome to come to school and wave them off! Children should come to school in their own clothes on Friday.

Can your child please bring a named water bottle, so that they are able to take water to each activity they take part in. I have attached a copy of the kit list again as a reminder; please note that children will need to wear long sleeves and trousers for most activities and long hair must be tied back. I will be in touch with the programme schedule, of all of the fun activities that the children will be taking part in over the duration of the weekend. Definite events will be 'Abseiling, 3G Swing, Climbing and Campfire'. Please log onto www.kingswood.co.uk for further information about what the centre offers.

Can you please label all clothing that your child brings, so that any missing items can be easily located. Permanent marker pens are great for this! Aerosols are not allowed but roll-on deodorants can be used. The Centre **WILL NOT** be responsible for any loss of personal property your child brings. Therefore, please do not let them bring anything valuable, including expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones, handheld games consoles etc. No electronic devices are permitted.

Your child may want to bring a book to read, a colouring or writing pad or a card game, for some activities for them to do before bed time and during other down times.

There is a small shop on site where children can buy snacks and souvenirs and we recommend that children bring no more than £10. **Can all pocket money and medication be given to Miss Taylor or Mrs Doherty in the School Hall in clearly labelled bags/envelopes, when you drop your child to school with their luggage on Friday 11th June.**

The group **should be back at school by approximately 2.00 pm on Sunday** and you will be sent a text just before departure. Please check the Twitter feed on our website over the weekend for regular updates!
