Beech Visit to Chessington World of Adventures

As part of our topic work on forces and motion, we are currently planning a Beech Class school trip to Chessington World of Adventures, Chessington, on **Monday 5th July 2021**.

As part of the trip, we will be attending a workshop on 'Forces'. In this workshop, the children will explore what makes the rides at Chessington work. They will also have the chance to find out about the forces we need for the rides through hands-on activities. The children will also have the chance to go on a selection of rides and attractions appropriate for their age and height.

We shall be leaving St. Paul's promptly at 8.30 am, please arrive no later than 8:15 am. We will aim to return after the end of the school day at 4.30 pm. Please note that this return timing is an estimate and is subject to change on the day, due to traffic however, we will contact you via Schoolcomms if we are severely delayed. The children should wear full school uniform and bring a warm waterproof raincoat. Your child will require a packed lunch for the trip, in a disposable bag with two bottles of water, as unfortunately the water fountains at Chessington, are not currently operating. As normal, this should be a healthy lunch that will keep the children full of energy for the trip!

The cost of the trip is £15.00, which, due to a special school's discount, is significantly less than the ordinary price. The price of this trip has also been made significantly cheaper by the use of the school's minibus.

Your child will not need to bring any spending money and we will not require any parent helpers on this occasion.
