We will be continuing with children wearing PE Kit into school on the relevant day. Children will also be doing Forest School on the same day so will need suitable clothing for this to put over the top of their PE kit, and a change of shoes.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that school PE kit consist of navy shorts, red school PE polo shirt with logo and plimsolls/trainers. For the colder weather, children will need a plain navy tracksuit or the school one, these can also be worn for Forest School.

On the days that children do not have PE and Forest School, full school uniform is required. For further details, please view the school website. Please note that children must have their blazers in school every day. School shoes should be plain black and children should not wear boots or trainers as part of their school uniform. Bows and other hair accessories are not part of school uniform.

This year, to mark the start of the academic year, we will be holding a church service at St. Paul's Church, led by Vicar Johnny between 9.00 am and 9.15 am. This service is open to all families and you will be able to sit with your children should you decide to stay. If you are attending, instead of dropping your child off at 8.45 am, please go straight to the church. If you are unable to stay, please drop your child at school at the times above.
