TIMETABLE

- We will be doing P.E and Forest School on a **Thursday** this year.
- When we do Forest School in year groups, it will be on a Thursday, whilst the children are already dressed in their PE kit.
- We will start the year with both Year 1 and 2 doing RWI phonics on a daily basis. Then, Year 2 will move on to ESG daily.
- Children will have their reading books changed over on a **Monday**. It is expected that children are reading at home at least 4 times a week and want to highlight the importance of you reading with them.
- We are currently completing reading assessments this week and their new reading books will be given out on **Monday**.

CONTINUOUS PROVISION

- We teach through continuous provision within Oak Class. Children have a right to access all of the KS1 curriculum which is why we adopt a cross-curricular approach to our lessons.
- Challenges - We will have focus groups running across the week for the completion of our learning challenges that are set at the beginning of the week and are completed in class.
- We use independent journals for the children to showcase the learning journey that they have been on and is a way for them to express their learning in different ways.



HOMework

- The children will be set online weekly spellings and Mathletics each week.
- Spelling shed will be based on phonics for year 1 and RWI rule of the week for year 2.
- This will be set on a **Monday** and will be due in on the following Monday.
- We will stick the children's logins for Spelling shed and Mathletics in the front of their contact books.

SATS

- Year 2's will sit their KS1 SATs in the summer and they start the week beginning the **Monday 2nd May 2022.**
- The children will partake in these assessments over the space of a few weeks. SATS will be completed by the students individually. They will sit:
 - 2 x maths papers (fluency and reasoning)
 - 2 x reading papers
 - 1 x ESG paper

YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING CHECK

- The year 1 phonics screening test will start the week beginning **Monday 6th June 2022**.
- We will space the tests out throughout the week, similar to the KS1 SATS.
- It shows us how the children are progressing in their phonics knowledge. These assessments will be carried out by classroom teachers with each child individually.
- Your child will be asked to read words aloud. They will be asked to use their blending skills to read the words. It only normally takes a few minutes to complete and there is no time limit.
