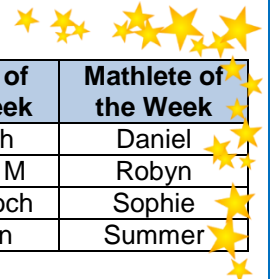
## Headteacher Hot Chocolate
