Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Maple Class Visit to Kent Life

As part of our curriculum study this term, we have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and the Victorian era. We would like to take the children on a visit to **Kent Life in Maidstone**, to bring the topic alive, through two interactive workshops. This will take place on **Wednesday 20th October 2021**. The full address of Kent Life is: Lock Ln, Sandling, Maidstone, ME14 3AU. Please can you bring your child to school promptly on the morning of the trip, so we are able to register the children and leave swiftly on the school minibus. We anticipate the travel time to be approximately half an hour.

The workshops will involve the children experiencing a 'Victorian Schoolroom' and they will learn about 'Victorian Children & Jobs'. Both of the workshops are designed to broaden the children's understanding of the era and allow them to ask questions to experts of the topic.

The children should wear a full school uniform with sensible walking shoes. Wellington boots or trainers would be ideal and they need a warm waterproof jacket for all weather eventualities. The children will need to bring a full packed lunch for the day in a disposable bag. Please no vacuum flasks or glass bottles.

The cost of this trip is **£12.50 per child**. This includes entry to Kent life, a tour guide at the site plus two specialist subject workshops. This should be paid directly via the School Comms app under the title '**Kent Life Maple Class**'. We will leave the payment open **until Friday 15th October**. You can pay the amount in increments or all at once; whichever is more convenient for you.

We anticipate returning to school at normal pickup time; should this time change on the day we will alert you via text on the School Gateway app.
