Beech Visit to The Natural History Museum – Friday 15th October 2021

As part of our topic on prehistoric Britain for history and the rock cycle in science, we are bringing this topic to life, by taking the children on a visit to The Natural History Museum, on **Friday 15th October 2021**.

From exhibits in the museum of 'Dinosaur Discoveries, British Wildlife, What on Earth?, Science News, and Dippy the Diplodocus 3D Rotating Skull', there should be plenty to see and enjoy for all the children!

We will be taking the children by train from Swanley train station to Victoria. We will then catch a tube for 2 stops to West Kensington tube station, which is a 5-minute walk to the museum. **We will be taking the 9:05am train, so please can you drop your children to Swanley train station no later than 8:55am.** Please leave yourself plenty of time to be at Swanley train station, as we will not be able to wait for late arrivals, due to a 10am time slot being booked for us at the museum. **If your child is late, they will not be taken on the trip.**

We will be returning on the 15:25pm train, due into Swanley train station at 15:51pm. Please collect your child at the train station for this time. We will assemble all children ready to be collected. If there is any change to the return time, we will alert you by School Comms on the that day.

The children should wear full school uniform and bring a warm waterproof raincoat. Your child will require a packed lunch for the trip, that they are able to carry all day in a rucksack. Please can they bring two bottles of water. As normal, this should be a healthy lunch that will keep the children full of energy for the trip! **They do not require spending money as we will not be visiting any shops.**

The cost of the trip is £10.00 per child and should be payed via School Gateway, under the payment 'Natural History Museum'. **Please can full payment be made by Friday 22nd October.**
