Dear Parents/Carers of Birch Class,

Birch Class Visit to Eagle Heights

Last Term the children enjoyed the book we read in class called 'Owl Babies', written by Martin Waddell. The story is all about a family of owls living together, and focuses on the owl babies waiting for their parents to return from their evening hunt. We would like to take the children for a visit to Eagle Heights in Eynsford, where they will get an opportunity to see real owls in the flesh and many other spectacular birds of prey.

The trip will take place on **Monday 6th December 2021**. We shall be travelling via the school minibus and will be leaving St. Paul's at approximately 10 am. If your child uses a booster seat, please provide us with it on the morning of the trip and stick a label with their name on it please. We will aim to return to school, at normal school pickup time of 3:15 pm. Please note that this return timing is an estimate subject to change on the day, we will contact you via Schoolcomms if we are delayed.

The children should wear their full school uniform and bring a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves to keep them warm, as most of the trip will take place outside. Your child will require a packed lunch, in a disposable bag and a bottle of water. As always, this should be a healthy lunch that will keep the children full of energy for the trip! Your child will be required to carry their own lunch and coat on the day, so a small back pack may be helpful for them to carry.

The cost of the trip is £8.50, which includes entry into Eagle Heights, a birds of prey display and travel to and from the venue. Please pay via the School Gateway app, under the payment 'Birch Trip to Eagle Heights'. Please pay in full by **Friday 3rd December 2021**.

Your child will not need to bring any spending money and we will not require any parent helpers on this occasion.
