### **Bikeability Cycle Training – May 2022**

Bikeability is a National Standard cycle training course comprising of 3 levels, designed to give the next generation of children, the skills and confidence to ride their bikes on today's roads. This is an important skill, especially as the children begin to travel to secondary school and become more independent with their friends.

**Therefore, we have organised cycle proficiency sessions for all our Year 6 students.** This training will cover level 1 and 2 and will teach them about how to control their bicycle, to make manoeuvres safely and improve hazard awareness. It will show them how to complete basic cycle safety checks, improve their knowledge of important road signs and increase their observational skills when cycling on the road. The cost of this very important life-skill will be £12 per child. A payment has been set-up on School Comms of £12, called 'Y6 Bikeability 2022'. You can pay this fee all at once, or in increments and the payment will close on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

**The course requires that your child should use their own bike and bike helmet and these should be brought to school on the two days that your child takes part in their training.** If this is a problem, please let Mrs Doherty in the school office know. The children will be grouped into A and B groups; we will let you know closer to the time, what group your child is in. The sessions will run as follows:

<b>Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2022</b> All day 09:00 – 15:00	GROUP A (AM) & B (PM)	Level 1 – on the playground
<b>Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022</b> All day 09:00 – 15:00	Group A All Day	Level 2 – on the road all day
<b>Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2022</b> All day 09:00 – 15:00	Group B All Day	Level 2 – on the road all day

I have attached a 'Parents Handbook' for you to read through before the course and a '**Parental Consent Form**' that needs to be completed and returned to Mrs Doherty in the school office. You can either email a completed copy through, or send a paper copy to the school office. **Please note that your child will not be able to attend the course, unless the consent form has been completed and returned.**
