We have been very lucky to be allocated 16 free tickets, to attend a literary festival at **Chiddingstone Castle, Hill Hoath Road, Chiddingstone, Kent, TN8 7AD on Tuesday 3rd May 2022**. There will be a host of authors on display throughout the day, along with exciting stalls for the children browse at.

The children will attend two authors workshops, Piers Torday on *The Wild Before*, and Christopher Lloyd. Chiddingstone castle is set on beautiful grounds and the children can enjoy exploring the castle grounds and its collections. They can also have their lunch on the extensive lawns.

The children should wear a full school uniform with sensible walking shoes. They will need a warm, waterproof jacket for all weather eventualities. The children will need to bring a full packed lunch in a disposable bag and a bottle of water, which they can refill.
