Maple — Term 6

English	During this term the children will be studying the text, 'The Song from Somewhere else.' The children will be producing diaries, poetry and letter writing.
Maths	The children are going to be learning about volume and capacity, statistics, algebra and ratio this term. We will also be revising key number concepts.
Science	The children will be learning about sustainability; thinking about which materials are made from, what recycling is and what global warming is.
Geography	During this term the children will be learning about globalisation, learning what it is and how it affects topics such as trade and fashion.
Art/DT	In Art, the children will be looking at different sculptures and construction using risk taking and creative thinking.
Music	The children will be continuing ukulele lessons with Mr Winston, learning notes and performing in different contexts. They will be singing in live performances.
Computing	In Computing the children will be learning what networks and 3D modelling, establishing what the children know about the internet and designing models.
RE	The children will be thinking about 'Kingdom of God,' understanding Christian beliefs on what kind of king Jesus is.
PE	The children will be learning about athletics, skills needed for different athletic events, as well as some rounders skills.
