### Year 6 'Safety in Action' Event – Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2022

We have made arrangements for Year 6 to attend an annual interactive safety event at **Cobham Hall School in Gravesend, DA12 3BL on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July**. You can find more information on this national event via [www.salusgroup.org.uk](http://www.salusgroup.org.uk)

It is an interactive event that invites Year 6 children to attend sessions that help them to become more independent and prepare them for the transition into secondary school. The topics that the event will cover are:

- Fire, Water, Electricity, Road, Passenger and Railway Safety
- Drugs/Alcohol
- Personal Safety
- Friends (Resilience)
- Emergency Life Support
- School Attendance
- Exploitation

The children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day and a water bottle that can be refilled. They must wear school uniform, including a blazer. However the event is held outside under marquees on the grass, so please ensure that the children have suitable sensible shoes for walking and bring a rain mac should it rain on the day! For hotter weather, sunscreen should be applied before school, and a cap worn if the children prefer.

**The group will leave by coach at approximately 11.45am and are expected back at school for 3.30pm.** Should the return time change on the day, we will alert you via School Gateway.

We already have your consent for your child to take part in activities of this type, but please contact the School Office if your child is unable to attend.
