

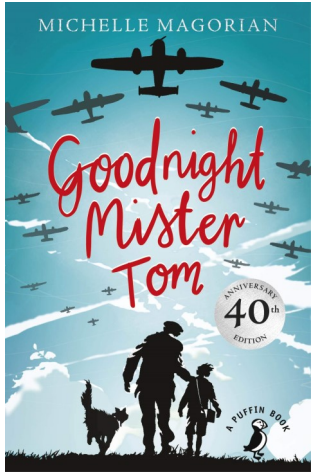

Maple — Term 5

English	During this term the children will be studying the text, 'Goodnight Mr Tom.' The children will be producing diaries, newspaper reports and narrative writing.
Maths	The children are going to be learning about geometry, studying angles and how to use a protractor. They will also learn about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
Science	The children will be learning about reproductive cycles, thinking about pollination and fertilisation, as well as sexual and asexual reproduction.
History	During this term the children will be learning about different twentieth century conflicts, with a particular focus on the causes of World War One and Two.
Art/DT	In Art, the children will be looking at different pictures produced by artists and the stories that these represent. The children will evaluate and create drawings.
Music	The children will be continuing their ukulele lessons with Mr Winston, learning notes and having the opportunities to perform in solo and group contexts.
Computing	In Computing the children will be learning what Text Adventures are, before producing their own and also having the opportunities to produce their own games.
RE	The children will be thinking about what is more important—generosity and charity or art and architecture within religions, comparing Muslim and Christian giving.
PE	The children will be learning about Tag Rugby and developing their passing, running and tagging skills, before competing in some Tag Rugby games.
