



Oak — Term 5

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| English | The children will be looking at the text 'Lila and the Secret of Rain' this term. There will be a focus on exploring narrative writing and looking closely at the plot and the characters in the book. The children will also be exploring what a non-chronological report is and writing their own later on in the term. |
| Maths | The children will be continuing to develop their number and problem solving skills in maths this term. They will be focusing on recognizing 2D and 3D shapes. They will also be exploring measurement and be able to use appropriate standards of measurement. |
| Science | This term in science, the children will be learning about 'Seasonal Changes'. They will be looking closely at the different seasons and will be able to describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies. |
| Geography | In geography this term, we will be exploring Africa, through culture, food and animals. Our core text explores a girl from a small Kenyan village which will also support this learning. |
| Art/DT | The children will be focusing on abstract composition in art. They will be developing a wide range of art and design techniques using colour, texture and shape. |
| Music | The children will be continuing to explore drumming with Mr Winston as their music learning for this term. They will continue to perform and create music and become more confident in performing to an audience. |
| Computing | In computing, the children will be exploring coding. They will be developing their instruction writing and starting to understand computer programming. |
| RE | In R.E, the children will be exploring Judaism. They will be looking at who is Jewish and what do they believe? |
| PE | The children will be learning about agility, balance and coordination in their P.E lessons with Coach Ashley this term. We will also be swimming each week which will support the development of these three skills. |
