

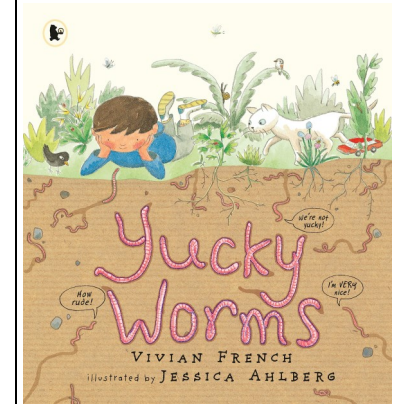

Birch—Term 6

Literacy	Our focus text this term is 'Yucky Worms' by Vivian French'. We are focusing on independently writing short sentences using known phonics, and using a capital letter and full stop consistently. We are also working on the children re-reading their sentences to ensure that they make sense.
Maths	In maths we are going to be learning to double and halve numbers. We are also going to be learning about odd and even numbers.
Communication and Language	We are going to be focusing on using newly learnt vocabulary in different contexts. We are working on describing events in some detail.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We are going to be thinking about considering the perspectives of other people, as well as managing our own needs.
Physical Development	We are going to be focusing on developing overall body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility. We are working on combining different movements with ease and fluency. We will be doing athletics, rounders and swimming.
Understanding the World	We are going to be focusing on drawing information from a simple map.
Expressive Arts and Design	We are going to be focussing on creating art collaboratively sharing ideas, resources and skills. We will be painting with plasticine.
RE	We are going to be learning about stories that are told by and about people of different faiths and beliefs.
