Maple—Term 2

English	The children will be exploring 'The Journey'. This text is a picture book about a child's perspective of being forced to leave their home. The imagery will be the driving force behind our diary and letter writing. In Destination Reader, we will be looking at 'Welcome to Nowhere' which also explores another child's perspective of having to flee home.
Maths	We will start this term by looking at multiplication and division. The children will be using formal methods to solve word problems that engage with problem solving and reasoning. After this, we will move on exploring fractions. The children will be required to work with fractions in a variety of ways.
Science	This term we are going to be studying forces. By the end of the unit, the children will have a greater understanding of the different natural and applied forces in existence. This will be explored through practical investigations, where the children will be given the opportunity to test applied forces for themselves but also study the theory behind them.
Geography	The children will be learning about slums around the world. They will explore what a slum is and how they develop. They will also explore examples of slums such as Rochinha and Dharavi and compare the physical and human features of each area. This will end with an academic essay on if governments should intervene and shut down slums.
Art/DT	In this pathway children are introduced to the work of a craftsperson/designer, and they explore how the artist brings their personality to their work. They go on to explore chair design over the centuries to understand how furniture can reflect or define the age in which it was made. They will also be making their own chairs during this process.
Music	During Autumn 2, the children will be having drumming lessons with Mr Winston. Also, they will take part in regular singing practice. This is an opportunity to work together as a whole-school choir and consider things like harmonies and melodies. We will be exploring songs such as 'Proud', 'Sing from Your Heart' and 'Go the Distance'.
Computing	This term the children will be using Purple Mash to reflect on online safety. They will explore their responsibilities and support when online. They will also consider how they can protect their privacy by considering how to maintain secure passwords and monitoring what they post online.
RE	In RE this term, the children will be able to explain the place of incarnation and messiah within the 'big story' of the Bible. They will also explain connections between biblical texts and discuss how Christians put their beliefs about Jesus' incarnation into practice in different ways in celebrating Christmas.
PE	The children will be having PE Lessons on a Monday where they will be learning about netball and basketball. They will consider how they can compete in games and improve their ball control and dribbling.
