Beech Trip Sea Life Brighton – Tuesday 20th December 2022

To fit in with our topic of habitats and living things, we have arranged to take the children to **Sea Life Brighton, Marine Parade, Brighton, BN2 1TB, on Friday 20th January 2023**. Sea Life Brighton houses over 5,500 amazing sea creatures and children will get the opportunity to touch a star-fish or sea anemone, in the interactive rock-pool area. They will also take part in a specialist workshop, to further develop their knowledge of habitats and living organisms.

The children should wear a full school uniform, with sensible walking shoes. They will need a warm, waterproof coat. The children will need to bring a full packed lunch in a disposable bag and a bottle of water, which they can refill. Please can everything your child needs, be put in a backpack that they are able to carry for themselves throughout the trip.

The cost of the trip is £10, which includes travel to and from the venue via the school minibuses, entry to Sea Life Brighton and a specialist workshop. This can be paid directly via the Schoolcomms app, under the title '**Beech Trip to Sea Life Brighton**'. We appreciate that Christmas is a very expensive time of year, with this in mind we will keep the payment open until Friday 27th January.

Please can the children can arrive at school by 8:10am, as we aim to leave promptly at 8:15am. We will be returning to school at approximate 3:30pm, should this change on the day we will alert you via Schoolcomms.
