Dear Parents/Carers,

Young Voices Concert at the O2 Arena – Tuesday 17th January 2023

With a week to go until our exciting concert in London, here are the final arrangements for the day.

What to wear?

In the morning, children need to wear their school uniform. We will provide a Young Voices t-shirt for the children to change into for the concert.

What to bring?

We will be leaving at approximately 1:00pm, so children will have their school dinner at school; or a packed lunch to eat as usual. Additionally, children will need to pack a tea to have for their evening meal at the O2. Please ensure that you pack plenty of soft drinks as it can get hot at the arena; plus plenty of healthy snacks and an extra water for your child for the evening. This should be in a disposable bag and not in a lunch box. A backpack for the children to carry all of their things would be really useful.

What time will we leave and return?

We will be leaving school at approximately **1:00pm**, to reach the O2 for afternoon rehearsals. The concert **starts at 7:00pm** and is due to **finish at 8:45pm**. The children will then get the coach back to school and are expected to **arrive at 10:00/10:15pm**. We will notify you via Schoolcomms if this time changes on the evening. Please note that we are not able to arrange to meet any parents at the O2.

The following morning

As we will be back very late on Tuesday evening, Mr Hulme has agreed that the children can have a small lie-in! We ask that the children be in school **by 10:00am on Wednesday 18th**, as we will be starting our learning at this time and don't want to interrupt the children's learning, with late arrivals.

Please continue to encourage your children to learn the words for all songs. I would like to thank the children for their hard work in preparation for the concert; I am sure they will have a fantastic evening!
