Dear Parents and Carers,

Oak Class Visit to Bore Place

As part of next term's topic on habitats, we have booked a class trip to Bore Place, Chiddingstone, Kent, TN8 7AR, on **Friday 5th May 2023**.

As part of the trip, the children will have a specialised program designed for their day, which will be based around animals and their habitats. We will have a dedicated guide, to work with our class for the whole day!

We shall be leaving St. Paul's promptly at 9am, please make sure that your child is brought to school on-time, we will not be able to wait for late children on the day. We will aim to return to school for a normal pickup time of 3:15pm. Should this time change on the day, we will alert you via Schoolcomms.

The children should wear full school uniform and bring a warm waterproof raincoat, hat and gloves if it is cold. Your child will require a healthy packed lunch for the trip and a refillable water bottle, in a disposable bag inside a small backpack, so they are able to carry their lunch with them on the day. **The children also need to bring a pair of wellington boots in a spare named bag, to change into on the day. They will be mostly working outside, and Bore Place will not allow them to wear muddy shoes in the centre. They should wear their normal school shoes to school and can change into their wellingtons at the centre.**

The cost of the trip is £12.00 per child. This includes entry to Bore Place, a guide and transport via the school minibuses. The payment can be paid all at once, or in £1 increments. Payment should be made via Schoolcomms, under the payment 'Oak Bore Place Trip'. Payment will close on Thursday 4th May 2023. **Unfortunately, we are unable to refund any child who is unable to make the trip on the day.**
