### Year 6 Residential to Stubbers Adventure Centre – Monday 12<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023

Thank you to those of you who have paid the deposits and the balance for your child's upcoming residential stay at Stubbers. **The final balance is due by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023 via Schoolcomms under the payment 'Y6 Residential to Stubbers'**. This will take place at Stubbers Adventure Centre, Ockenden Road, Upminster, Essex, RM14 2TY.

Mr Johnson and Miss Craft will be accompanying the children on this trip. The group will be leaving school on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June after school, at approximately 3:30pm** and will travel to and from the site via the School minibus.

Can your child please bring a named water bottle, so that they are able to take water to each activity they take part-in. I have attached a generic copy of the recommended 'kit list' for your child once again, please note that children will need to wear long sleeves and trousers for most activities and long hair must be tied back. Please send clothes and trainers that you don't mind getting muddy and that are easily washable. The children will be taking part in lots of age appropriate and fun activities over the three days. Can you please label all clothing, so that any missing items can be easily located. Permanent marker pens are great for this! The Centre **WILL NOT be responsible for any loss of personal property your child brings**. Therefore, please do not let them bring anything valuable, including expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones, handheld games consoles etc. **No electronic devices are permitted**. Your child may wish to bring a book to read, a colouring or writing pad or a card game, for some activities for them to do before bed time and during other down times.

There is a small shop on site, where children can buy snacks and drinks in the evenings and we recommend that children bring no more than £10. **Can all pocket money and medication be given to Mr Johnson in a clearly labelled bag, envelope, purse or wallet, with your child's name on it and the amount of money provided. Please drop this off with your child's luggage to the back of the school hall, when you drop your child to school on the morning of Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June.**

The group **should be back at school on Wednesday at approximately 4.30pm, we will send you a text via Schoolcomms on the day, should this time change**. Please check the Twitter feed on our website over the three days, for regular updates!
