MESSAGE FROM MR JOHNSON

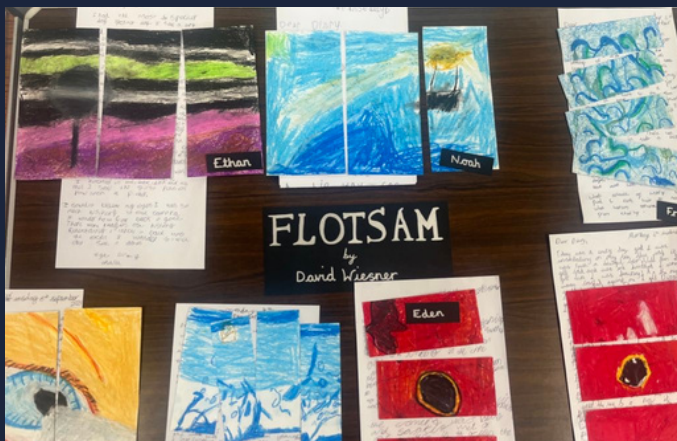
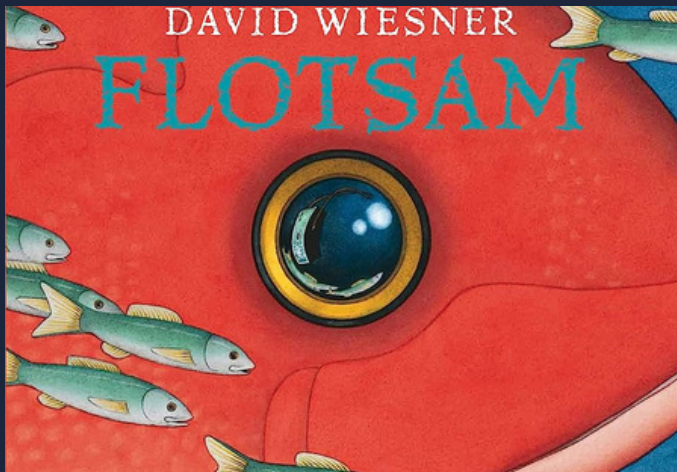
