Year 6 Residential to Stubbers Adventure Centre - Monday 1st – Wednesday 3rd July 2024

I am very pleased to let you know, that we have managed to secure a really exciting residential for our Year 6's to take part in, to commemorate their time with us at St. Paul's. This will take place at **Stubbers Adventure Centre, Ockenden Road, Upminster, Essex, RM14 2TY.**

The 3 days away, will provide exciting and challenging activities, run by an experienced and qualified team of outdoor professionals. From activities such as kayaking, canoeing, archery, leap of faith and laser tag, there is bound to be something for everyone! The focus of the weekend will be on building teamwork skills and confidence; to take risks and persevere when faced with challenges and to help prepare the children for their next steps into secondary school. The children will gain a great deal from attending this weekend away and take with them fond memories of Year 6 and their friends at St. Paul's, which they can treasure long after they have left us!

The group will depart from St. Paul's at approximately 3:30pm on Monday 1st July and will travel by the school mini-bus. They will be leaving the centre on **Wednesday 3rd July at approximately 3:30pm**, arriving back at St. Paul's School at approximately by 4:30pm. We will keep you updated on the day via School Comms, should any timings change.

The cost of the weekend trip will be **£225** and this includes all activities, food and travel to and from the centre. **We are asking for a £50 non-refundable deposit to be paid by Wednesday 31st January 2024**, this can be paid all at once, or in smaller increments via School Comms, under the payment 'Y6 Stubbers Residential 2024'. The minimum amount is £5, per payment, with a reducing balance. We have set the payment for the deposit out until the end of January, as we know how expensive this time of year is for everyone! Please also tick the consent box in Schoolcomms for your child to attend. We will send full details of what children should bring, closer to the date.
