As part of our science curriculum, Beech Class have been learning about 'Fossils and Rocks', and we are pleased to have arranged a school trip to Folkestone Museum, to further explore this fascinating subject.

During a hands-on workshop called 'Fossils and Rocks', the children will have the opportunity to apply the knowledge they have been acquiring in their science lessons. The workshop is designed to be interactive and engaging, allowing the children to explore and discover the wonders of geology and palaeontology, in both a fun and educational way.
