Oak -Term 2

English	In our writing this term we will be reading our class text 'Beegu. There are many themes and lessons to be learned through this story and we are going to explore these themes through writing a letter from the perspective of Beegu and we will also be writing poetry. We will be thinking about thoughts and feelings and how to use these in our writing.
Maths	Year 1 - We are going to be focused around addition and subtraction this term, thinking about number bonds within ten, finding a part and using a number line to subtract numbers. Year 2 - We will learn how to add and subtract across 10, finding 10 more and 10 less and adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers. We will look at a range of word problems.
Science	In science this term we are going to continue our learning around everyday materials. We are going to learn how to build a variety of structures including structures that can with stand wind and structures that are waterproof. We are also going to learn about a variety of fabrics, understanding their properties and we will understand the properties of glass.
History	We are going to be learning about The Great Fire of London, we are going to learn about the properties of fire and how we can safely build a fire. We are also going to learn about London in 1966 and begin to think about the problems in London at this time. We are going to learn about the events of the Great Fire of London and how we know about them!
Art/DT	In art this term we are going to take a focus on watercolor painting. We are going to learn that watercolor paints have a range of special characteristics and we are also going to think about how elements of surprise and accident can help us in our artwork. We will develop our painting by reflecting on what we can see to add new colors and lines.
Music	In music this term we will be working with Mrs Armour to learn to play the xylophones. We will focus on getting to know this instrument to start with in order to familiarize ourselves with the most effective way to use it. We will then begin to learn about the different noises that are made and how we can change the sounds that come from the xylophone.
Computing	Our computing learning this term will be focused around the children becoming Lego Builders. We will be exploring how we can follow simple instructions to create simple instructions within the computer. We will also learn how to consider the order of instructions and how this can affect the result of the product you are creating through the computer.
RE	In our RE learning this term we will be focusing on why Christmas matters to Christians. We are going to learn that Christians believe Jesus is God and that he was born in Bethlehem. We are also going to think about how the Bible points of Jesus' birth to show Jesus as extraordinary. The children will also learn about advent and what this means.
PE	In PE this term we will be working alongside Miss Bracken to develop our football and hockey skills. We will be thinking about effective passing, how to kick and hit the ball accurately and what to do when someone passes the ball to us in a variety of different situations. We will also get to play a variety of team games to build our teamwork.
