


## ST. PAUL'S NEWS

This week, Beech Class have started trialling ClassDojo. ClassDojo is digital sharing platform that allows teachers to document the day in class and share that with families via a web browser so that nearly any device can access the content – from a simple smartphone to a laptop computer. As long as it has a browser, photos and videos can be viewed. The children also receive Dojo Points which can be exchanged for rewards.

Dojo points will be rewarded for good behaviour throughout the week. At St. Paul's, we shall be awarding these points for:
