Oak -Term 3

English	In our writing this term we will be reading our class text 'The Secret of Black Rock'. This story explores the ocean and the wider world and we will be creating poems, thinking about these themes. We will also look at the issues surrounding the oceans and the children will write persuasive arguments about saving our oceans.
Maths	Year 1 - The children will learn to recognize 3D shapes and will work to sort 2D shapes. They will also begin to think about place value within 20, exploring addition and subtraction. Year 2 - We will be learning about shape, thinking about vertices and sides and how to show a line of symmetry. We will also look at faces and edges on 3D shapes.
Science	In science this term we are going to dig even deeper into our learning around materials. We will be thinking about more complex materials in our world and their uses. We will also be learning about the best materials to use within construction and we will explore stretchiness, twisting and bending of materials through practical exploration.
Geography	We are going to be learning about weather and field work. We will be learning what weather is and how the weather is explored in our wider world. We will also learn about how decisions are made about weather and the information that needs to be explored. The children will get into the role of weather explorers, researching and presenting data!
Art/DT	In art this term we are going to take a focus on print, colour and collage. We will be thinking about printing with everyday materials and how this looks. We will explore printing with a range of materials and think about how this looks in different forms of paint, charcoal, pencil etc.
Music	In music this term we will be working with Mrs Armour to learn to play the xylophones. We will focus on getting to know this instrument to start with in order to familiarize ourselves with the most effective way to use it. We will then begin to learn about the different noises that are made and how we can change the sounds that come from the xylophone.
Computing	Our computing learning this term will be focused around grouping and sorting. The children will explore how to use Purple Mash to group and sort objects, they will begin to think about how different codes can support this. The children will also work to create their own pictures and then group and sort these using Purple Mash.
RE	In our RE learning this term we will be exploring Judaism. The children will be learning about Jewish people in our world, thinking about their beliefs and how they live their lives. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to extend their knowledge of religions in our world, learning about how people of different faiths live and believe.
PE	In PE this term we will be working alongside Miss Bracken to develop our volleyball skills. We will be thinking about effective passing, using different methods of transporting the ball and how to effectively ensure that we follow the rules of this game. The children will have lots of opportunities to be involved in matches during PE lessons.
