Maple—Term 3

English	Wonder addresses themes of prejudice, friendship, the essential ‘unknowability’ of others’ inner lives and the rules by which we choose to live our own. The children will explore the moral issues about how we treat each other and how to empathise with characters. We will use the information to write for a wide range of purposes and audiences.
Maths	This term we will explore multitude of mathematical concepts consisting of fractions, converting units of measurement, ratio and algebra. The children will be using their prior knowledge, manipulatives and strategies to aid their learning when using all operations and applying them to larger numbers.
Science	The children will identify the kingdoms of life and to classify living things within those kingdoms. The children will be introduced to the Linnean system of classification and will be able to develop their practical scientific skills through investigating mould growth on bread and mushroom spore dispersal.
History	The children will learn about what the United States of America were like in the 1950s. Also, they will look into key individuals during the civil rights movement in the USA during the 1950s and 1960s and the changes that occurred because of them. Furthermore, we will explore the state of race relations in the USA today.
Art/DT	In this pathway, the children are introduced to the work of Lubaina Himid and they explore how she paints on wood to create flat, standing images which viewers can walk amongst. They go on to explore drawing techniques such as grid drawing, using negative space, and mark making, before transforming your drawings into sculpture.
Music	During this term, the children will receive ukulele lessons where they will practice strumming and rhythms. Also, they will take part in regular singing practice. This is an opportunity to work together as a whole-school choir and consider things like harmonies and melodies. We will be practicing for ‘Young Voices’ at the o2.
Computing	In this unit, we will be learning about creating spreadsheets. We will use spreadsheets to: investigate the probability of the results of throwing a dice, calculate the discount on items, create a formula to help work out the prices of items in a sale and to plan how to spend pocket money.
RE	This term, we will explore the question ‘What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?’ They will learn from different religious and spiritual ways of life about being a follower of Islam. The children explore the five pillars of Islam, the importance of these to Muslim believers and will gain a greater understanding of Muslim’s beliefs, values and ideas.
PE	During PE the children will be focusing on developing their volleyball skills. The children will explore and learn the correct techniques to pass, serve and set when playing volleyball. In addition, we will also learn how to get into scoring positions by spiking and blocking the ball.

Wonder

This moving, humorous, and at times brutal novel tells the story of August Pullman, a boy with a rare facial disfigurement, who is starting school for the first time after being home-schooled by his mother.

Wonder explores the experience of living with a severe facial disfigurement and experience of those around Auggie, as they struggle with their own reactions to his face, with finding compassion, kindness and accepting the difference of others.
