Dear Parents/Carers of Beech Class,

Oak Class Visit to Wingham Wildlife Park – Friday 3rd May 2024

This term, the children in Oak class are learning about animals as part of their topic. They will be looking at different animal classes and groups, what they like to eat and their habitats. To bring this topic alive, we have arranged to take the children to Wingham Wildlife Park, on **Friday 3rd May 2024**. The full address is Rushham Road, Wingham, Canterbury, CT3 1JL.

Wingham Wildlife Park boasts having more species of animals, than any other wildlife park or zoo in Kent. They offer educational talks on all of the animals in their care and this includes, chimpanzees, flamingo's, lemurs, lions, penguins, red pandas and many more! There should be a favourite animal for everyone to enjoy.

We will be travelling to and from Wingham via the school minibuses. Please make sure that the children arrive at school for an earlier start of 8:15am, as we will be leaving promptly by 8:30am. Unfortunately we will not be able to arrive or take any children who are late. We aim to return to school for a slightly later pickup time of 3:30pm. Should this time change on the day, we will alert you via Dojo Announcements.

The children should wear a full school uniform with their school shoes, a waterproof coat and a hat and gloves if it is a cold day. The children will need a healthy packed lunch, with a refillable drinking bottle of water. Your child will be required to carry their own lunch on the day and a small backpack for this would be ideal. They will not need any spending money.

The cost of the trip is £10, which covers entry to Wingham Wildlife Park, all educational talks and travel via the school minibuses. Please pay via the School Gateway app, under the payment '**Oak Trip to Wingham Wildlife Park 2024**'. We will leave the payment open until **Friday 24th May 2024**.
