Dear Parents and Carers,

Final Details for A Night of Young Voices 2024 - Wednesday 22nd May

We cannot wait to showcase to you, the whole school choir's amazing singing at A Night of Young Voices 2024. From soloists, to a Year 6 harmony and dance routines, it is sure to be a memorable evening! I wanted to take this opportunity to run you through the final details of the event:

Lunch

We are leaving after lunch, so children are still able to have a hot meal should they wish to, or their usual packed lunch. Beech and Maple Classes will be departing for St. Peter's straight after lunch. They will be escorted by school staff, on a walk to the church.

Uniform

Full school uniform should be worn for the event. Blazers must be worn. Ideally, this should be the full winter uniform, including ties.

Oak and Birch Class Swimmers

Birch and Oak Class, will be shuttled to St. Peter's Church after their swim lessons in the afternoon. If your child is in this class and not attending, they will be taken back to St. Paul's, for a normal pick-up time of 3:15pm.

Water and a Healthy Snack

Please could you provide the children with a healthy afternoon snack, to keep them going between the end of school and the end of the concert. This would be in addition to their lunch. The children should come to school with their refillable water bottles, in order to keep them hydrated throughout the day.

My Child is Not Attending

All children not participating in the concert, will stay at St. Paul's for the duration of the day with members of staff. The children should be picked up at normal pick-up time. Once again, if your child is unable to attend please let me know. As you are aware, we have requested that ALL children take part in this celebration. As previously communicated, there will be no after school club with West Hill Life on this afternoon.

The Concert

The concert will take place on Wednesday 22nd May between 5-6pm, at **St. Peter's Church, College Road, Hextable, BR8 7RH**. Doors will open at 4.45pm and there is some car parking in the church car park. If this is full, please park considerately on the neighbouring roads or walk to the church if possible. The concert is free to attend and we encourage you to bring other family members along, to enjoy the performance. There will be an opportunity for cash donations, at the end of the event.

After the Concert

The concert is anticipated to finish at approximately 6pm. The children will be dismissed from St. Peter's Church. Please can you make the school office aware of any alternative pick-up arrangements for your child.
