Birch — Term 5

Literacy	Our focus texts this term is 'Jabari Tries' by Gaia Cornwall and 'Astro Girl' by Ken Wilson-Max. We are focusing on independently writing short sentences using known phonics, and securing our use of capital letters and full stops. We will be writing about characters, making information books, using our imaginations to continue stories, thinking about what we want to be when we grow up, and writing poems.
Maths	We are going to be exploring numbers to 20 and beyond. We will look at the pattern of numbers and watch how they grow in tens and ones. We will also be learning to add and subtract numbers. We will look at composing and decomposing shapes. We will look at finding shapes within other shapes.
Communication and Language	We are going to be working on using talk to solve any problems we might face. We will also focus on organising our thinking and activities, explaining how things work and why different things might happen.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We are going to be thinking particularly about considering the perspective of others. This includes how the choices we make, effect other people. We will also be working on managing our own needs and showing independence.
Physical Development	We will be focusing on combining different movements with ease and fluency. We are developing overall body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility. We are continuing to work on our fine motor skills with correct pencil grip for fluent handwriting and using scissors competently, safely and confidently.
Understanding the World	We are going to be talking about different members of our community and people in our lives. We will be learning about inventors, different materials and space!
Expressive Arts and Design	We are thinking about returning and building on our previous learning, refining ideas and taking on constructive criticism from others.
RE	We are going to be learning about world faiths through terms 5 and 6. We will be thinking about which stories are special and why, and about how stories help people to know how to behave. This term we will look at Jewish and Muslim stories.

Core Books

He consults books, finds out about inventors and inventions and makes careful plans but he just can't quite make it work. Then his dad suggests that partnering with his little sister Nika might help and together they produce a feat of engineering.
