

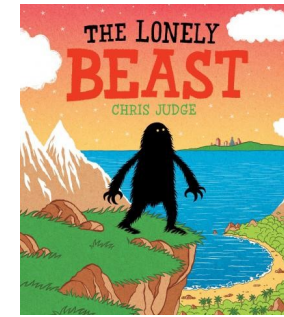

Oak -Term 5

English	In our writing this term we will be reading our class text 'The Lonely Beast'. We will explore the journey that the beast goes on, thinking about his feelings and writing a diary entry explaining the journey. We will also learn more about the features of narratives and letter writing to explore the journey the beast makes and the story to follow.
Maths	<b>Year 1</b> - the children will be exploring addition and subtraction within 20 thinking about number bonds to 20, doubles and counting back in order to subtract. <b>Year 2</b> - This term Year 2 will explore money, thinking about pounds and pence. We will also explore length and height, thinking about measuring in meters and comparing heights.
Science	In science this term we are going to be exploring Animals Including Humans: All About Animals. Our learning will include thinking about the 5 main animal groups and their characteristics, we will also be thinking about the similarities and differences between these different groups. The children will also explore what different animals eat and their habitats.
Geography	This term we are going to explore the countries of the UK. We are going to learn what the UK is and where people live within the UK. We are also going to learn the names of the countries within the UK and the capital cities within these countries. We are also going to learn what it is like in each country and capital city within the UK.
Art/DT	In art this term we are going to explore and draw using elements of the natural environment. We are going to explore a range of different drawing techniques from feeling objects to continuous line drawing. The children will also work to produce a range of different wax drawings using different techniques involving leaves!
Music	In music this term we will be working with Mr Crocker to learn to play the xylophones. In our lessons this term, we will be exploring a variety of different tunes and songs to develop our understanding of sound and how to change sound. The children will need to focus to ensure that they understand the different notes that they are playing!
Computing	In our computing lessons this term, the children will be exploring coding on Purple Mash. They will learn how to input different pieces of information and sequence different objects to make them move and perform different actions. They will explore basic codes to make games and puzzles move and become more interactive.
RE	During our RE learning this term, the children will be exploring Gospel: What is the good news that Jesus brings? We will be learning about forgiveness and peace and why these are both very important within Christianity. The children will also explore how Christians put these elements into practice within their churches and their communities.
PE	In PE this term we will be working alongside Miss Bracken to develop our tennis skills. We will be learning how to use different techniques when hitting the ball and what a forehand and backhand swing is. We will also learn how we should serve the ball accurately to our partners to ensure they can return the ball back across the net.
