Oak -Term 6

English	Our writing this term is going to be focused around our class text 'Ossiri and the Bala Mengro'. This fantastic story will allow the children to learn about different cultures and they will explore persuasive letter writing when trying to convince Ossiri's father to let her play an instrument. The children will also explore instructional writing!
Maths	Year 1 - The children will begin to explore multiplication and division. They will learn about creating equal groups and then adding these equal groups together. Year 2 - This term the children will begin to learn about fractions. They will learn about equal and unequal groups and they will also learn to recognize halves and quarters of shapes.
Science	In science this term we are going to be exploring Animals Including Humans: All About Me. The children will dive into the world of the human body, thinking about the basic parts of the human body. The children will learn about eyes and sight, ears and hearing, taste and the tongue and how our nose smells.
Geography	This term we are going to explore the countries of the UK. We are going to learn what the UK is and where people live within the UK. We are also going to learn the names of the countries within the UK and the capital cities within these countries. We are also going to learn what it is like in each country and capital city within the UK.
Art/DT	In our DT week this term we are going to explore a range of mechanisms. The children will get to explore sliding and levers, thinking about how these are used within our world and how these could be used to create their own product, the children will be able to explore a range of existing products and design their own product after creating research.
Music	In music this term we will be working with Mr Crocker to learn to play the xylophones. In our lessons this term, we will be exploring a variety of different tunes and songs to develop our understanding of sound and how to change sound. The children will need to focus to ensure that they understand the different notes that they are playing!
Computing	In our computing lessons this term, the children will be exploring coding on Purple Mash. They will learn how to input different pieces of information and sequence different objects to make them move and perform different actions. They will explore basic codes to make games and puzzles move and become more interactive.
RE	During our RE learning this term, we are going to revisit our learning about Easter from our previous years. The children will be learning why Easter matters to Christians and why it is an important part of their lives. The children will learn why Christians remember God at this time and how important it is to remember the Easter events and why they happened.
PE	In PE this term we will be working alongside Miss Bracken to develop our tennis skills. We will also begin to explore athletics, thinking about practicing for sports day. The children will be able to explore different types of jumping, a range of different thros and also running a range of different distances. They will get to showcase these skills at sports day!
