Maple — Term 6

English	During this term the children will be studying the text, 'The Song from Somewhere Else'. This is a deeply moving story about finding friendship when you least expect it. The children will be given the opportunity to write a narrative, poem and character description inspired from the text.
Maths	This term we will explore multitude of mathematical concepts consisting of shape, position and direction, negative numbers, converting units and volume. The children will be using their prior knowledge, manipulatives and strategies to aid their learning when using all operations and applying them to larger numbers.
Science	The children will explore electricity and learn how to compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
Geography	The children will learn about what globalisation is, how it has changed the way we communicate and how it affects trade. We will also explore how globalisation is linked with food, fashion and where it will lead us.
Art/DT	During DT the children will use have to design, sketch and plan their own free-standing structure. They will have to measure and cut materials accurately while assembling parts using a range of techniques. Lastly, the children will have to use their problem solving skills to assess any potential weaknesses in preparation to testing their structures.
Music	During this term, the children will receive ukulele lessons where they will practice strumming and rhythms. Also, they will take part in regular singing practice. This is an opportunity to work together as a whole-school choir and consider things like harmonies and melodies.
Computing	In Computing the children will be learning about networks with the opportunity to find out more about how they work, understand computer networks including the Internet, learn how they can provide multiple services, such as the World Wide Web, and explore the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration
RE	The children will be thinking about 'Kingdom of God,' understanding Christian beliefs on what kind of king Jesus is. We will be able to make clear connections between belief in the Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into practice in different ways
PE	The children will be learning about Athletics learning events for different athletic events, as well as some rounders skills. During Athletics they will enhance their coordination, agility, speed and strength through activities such as running, jumping and throwing.
