**Year 4 PGL Trip to Windmill Hill, Friday 8<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2024**

Here at St. Paul's, we have chosen to arrange overnight residentials, in a progressive manner to match the children's age and maturity. The children get a chance to experience life away from home with their friends in Year 2, for a one night stay, moving on to a 2 night residential in Year 4, with a final 3 day residential in Year 6. We have found that if a child feels apprehensive in Year 2 for their first overnight stay, by the time they reach Y6, their confidence has grown so much and they are really looking forward to their experience away from home.

We have arranged for Y4 to take part in an action packed and fun weekend away at PGL, Windmill Hill, East Sussex, Halisham, BN27 4RZ. The children will spend the weekend with their friends, enjoying lots of fun activities together, from Archery, Aeroball, Campfires, Giant Swing, Jacob's Ladder and a final evening of disco fun, there's bound to be something for everyone! The children will also get to experience some activities across their weekend with children across the Federation of our two other schools, who will also be taking part in the weekend away. The weekend will provide exciting opportunities for the children and is run by an experienced and qualified team of outdoor professionals. The total cost of the weekend is £150, which includes all activities, food, accommodation, bedding and transport. We require a non-refundable payment of £50 by **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024**, under the payment '**Y4 PGL to Windmill Hill Nov 2024**'. We have spread the cost of payment until the end of Term 3, which closes on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and you can pay for the trip in increments, with a minimum of £10 each time.
