



Maple—Term 1

English	The children will be exploring our class text 'Suffragette The battle for Equality'. This text is made up of short stories detailing the journey that women fought to gain equal rights. We will be looking at a range of different writing genres such as: diary writing, newspaper report and biographies.
Maths	We will start this term looking at number and place value. Children will be looking at numbers up to 1000000 and developing their skills of rounding and estimation. We will revisit Roman Numerals and negative numbers as well as adding and subtracting numbers mentally and using a written method.
Science	This unit deepens the children's understanding of life cycles, reproduction and animal characteristics. New concepts such as asexual reproduction and metamorphosis are introduced to help the children understand how life cycles are constantly progressing, whilst pre-existing concepts are continually referenced and built upon to aid recall and scaffold learning.
History	The children are going to be learning about the Benin Kingdom and how the dynasty evolved to becoming so successful. The children will study about what European countries first started trading with the Benin Kingdom and what goods were sold. Towards the end of the term we will learn about the transatlantic slave trade and the impact this had.
Art/DT	The children will be exploring how we can, as artists, use our skills, vision and creativity to speak on behalf of communities, changing the world for the better? This will be linked to our learning on the Suffragettes. They will considering artistic skills such as printing, collaging and drawing.
Music	During Autumn 1, the children will be having drumming lessons with Mr Winston. Also, they will take part in regular singing practice. This is an opportunity to work together as a whole-school choir and consider things like harmonies and melodies. We will be exploring songs such as 'Proud', 'Sing from Your Heart' and 'Go the Distance'.
Computing	This term the children will be using Purple Mash to consider advanced coding. They will be considering how programs can be de-bugged to fix errors that occur. Furthermore, they will be developing their own software that will be able to be used by a peer.
RE	In RE this term, the children will be consider what it means if God is loving and holy. They will explore this in their weekly RE lessons and have opportunities to ask question and discuss their own personal beliefs.
PE	The children will be having regular swimming lessons this term. They will also be continuing to have PE sessions with Coach Ashley. During these sessions, the children will be exploring netball and basketball. They will consider, space, tactics and ball control.
