



Beech — Term 3

English	This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book 'Tales of Wisdom and Wonder'. This is a fantastic collection of poetry that we will explore to develop our vocabulary and language learning. We are going to focus on the poem 'Monkey and Papa God', we will think about the honey in particular and write a rhyming poem around this.
Maths	Year 3—This term we are going to continue to develop our multiplication and division knowledge and we will be thinking about multiplying 2 digits by 1 digits. Year 4—This term Year 4 will also be developing their multiplication and division knowledge and we will be focusing on all of our times tables and being able to divide by these too.
Science	This term in Science, the children will be learning all about living things and their habitats. We will learn to recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. We will be looking at what ecosystems are and how these are affected by the seasons..
History	In History this term, we will be exploring the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We are going to learn how we know about the Anglo-Saxons and who invaded Britain after the Romans left. We are going to think about Anglo-Saxon life and what they believed. The heptarchy was an important part of Anglo-Saxon life and we are going to learn what this meant.
Art/DT	In art this term, Beech will be developing their sketching and drawing skills. We are going to look at a range of illustrations. We will take part in a range of drawing warm ups before moving on to storytelling. For our final project, we will be producing a range of illustrations for a story or poem.
Music	In the Spring term, Beech class will be getting ready for Young Voices and will spend time practicing the songs ready for the concert. They will also take part in drumming with Mr Winston, expanding their musical understanding and widening their use of musical language.
Computing	The children will be continuing to develop their computing skills this term and will be looking closely spreadsheets. We are going to learn about tables and how to add and delete data from a table. We will also find out how a spreadsheet program can automatically create graphs from the data in a table.
RE	In R.E, the children will be learning about Incarnation and we will be looking at what the Trinity is. We will think about different Gospels in the Bible and what these mean to Christians today. We will describe how Christians show their beliefs about God the Trinity in the way we live.
PE	This term in P.E, the children will be exploring team games and looking at Volleyball. The children will have opportunities to explore the fundamental skills associated with the sport alongside learning the rules involved in participating in the games.
